



How to write a compelling psychotherapist biography?

A compelling biography is very important for you to form an initial connection with your prospective clients and give them a reason to reach out to you. However, it is easy to feel stumped when it comes to writing a biography about yourself from scratch. If you've been staring at a blank screen for too long or can't seem to find the right words, start by writing answers to any or all of the following questions.

1. Do you have any areas of specialization, and what are they?
2. How does your personality influence your approach to therapy?
3. Describe issues you work with in therapy and your approach to helping with those issues. (For example, "My approach to treating anxiety is typically x, y, and z.")
4. What therapeutic methods, approaches, or philosophies do you embrace?
5. Are there any recurring themes or issues you've noticed as you treat people in your area of specialization? How has this insight guided your approach to helping?
6. What do you view as a key component of the therapeutic alliance/relationship between you and your clients?
7. How do your life philosophy and treatment philosophy overlap?

8. What is the most profound, insightful, or interesting thing you've learned as a mental health professional?
9. Which beliefs play a large role in your life?
10. How long have you been practicing?
11. What education do you have?
12. What certifications do you have?

Once you write your answers to most of these questions, take your answers and use them to craft a standout bio. If you have difficulty in creating a text that flows or you don't know how to structure your biography (e.g., what to start with, how to end), begin with emulating the structure of the biographies of our clinicians at <https://www.roamerstherapy.com/about-us/> and then iterate over your first draft.

Remember that your prospective clients will probably read your biography after reading tens of others. They will be eager to skip your profile if your biography is hard to read or it sounds too similar to the others. So, strive to write an original biography that is also clear and direct.
